What burdens are we to bear? v. 1 - Sins that our brothers or sisters are caught in.

James 5:19-20 - A brother wandering from obedience to Christ into sin is headed for death and disaster. Who is called to save him? His brother.

Two Warnings:

V. 5 - We must not bear their load for them.

V. 1 - We must not allow ourselves to fall into temptation as we help them.

It is easy to be deceived as Eve was, to believe that what the world has to offer is desirable and good for us. As we seek obedience to Christ, the world is constantly tempting us to partake, and we grow weary.

Jeremiah 2: The world = broken cisterns.
