Scriptural Considerations

1 Timothy 2:1-4 - Which candidate most closely leads us to living a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way?

Romans 13:1-4

Which Candidate Will Most Closely Lead to Godliness?

1 Timothy 2:1-4

Proverbs 14:34 - *Righteousness exults a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people.*

Concern - Trump's Character

Concern - Kamala's policies as evidence of her true character

What are some of those policies?

Abortion - Murder, no limitations, and wanting it to be tax-payer funded. She opposes the Hyde Amendment, which prevents the use of federal funds for abortions.

LGBTQ - Not merely wanting LGBTQ rights but wanting to force acceptance, approval, and celebration of LGBTQ by everyone.

Religious Freedom - She supported the Do Not Harm Act, which would have hurt religious protection in matters of discrimination.

Critical-Race Theory view of life - Identity politics. You are either an oppressor or the oppressed. And the oppressor group must be brought down so that the oppressed may be brought up.

Socialists agenda

Anti-Israelite Establishment - Regardless of one's view on Israel and our biblical responsibility to them, they have sided with the terrorist Muslims, having bought into CRT propaganda.

Who Is a Greater Terror to Bad Than to Good?

Romans 13:1-4 - Primarily verse 3 - They are not a terror to good conduct, but to bad.

1 Peter 2:13-14

Which Candidate Will Provide a Society More Open to the Gospel?

Religious liberty - Society change comes through Gospel change; thus, who will most freely allow gospel change to take place?

Can a Christian Vote for Kamala Harris?

Because of these reasons, I do not believe whatsoever that there is ANY biblical precedence for voting for Kamala.

What About Christians Who Do Not Believe They Can Vote for Trump?

Legitimate Concern:

Character - If righteousness exalts a nation, they cannot in good conscience vote for Trump.

Abortion

For the first time ever, the republican platform is not opposed to abortion. They don't necessarily support it, but they are not against it either. They want it to go to the states.

Would it have been ok to vote for Hitler because he has a good economic policy?

- **Romans 1:32** - We must not even give approval to those who practice evil. Is voting for someone giving approval?

Considerations:

- Harris and Walz will be the most radical abortion advocates ever in the White House. There will practically be zero restriction. So in some ways, voting for Trump is still saving lives.
- But there are other Christians who say that they can never vote for any person who supports abortion to any degree.
- Though they know that this probably means Harris will win, its a sacrifice worth making.

Romans 14:23 - *But whoever has doubts is condemned if he eats, because the eating is not from faith. For whatever does not proceed from faith is sin.*
