A frequent command God gives to His people throughout scripture is to remember. God implores Israel to remember His faithfulness and forget not His benefits. Psalm 77:11-12 says, "I will remember the deeds of the Lord; yes, I will remember your wonders of old.

I will ponder all your work, and meditate on your mighty deeds."

One way the Israelites practiced this is to set up Ebenezers. In 1 Samuel 7:12 we see Samuel doing this to commemorate the Lord giving Israel victory over the Philistines, "Then Samuel took a stone and set it up between Mizpah and Shen and called its name Ebenezer; for he said, 'Till now the Lord has helped us."

An Ebenezer was a stone set up as a marker for the Israelites to remember all that God had done for them. We see this in the crossing of the Jordan in Joshua 4. This is what is meant by verse 2 in "Come, Thou Fount of Every Blessing": "Here I raise mine Ebenezer hither by Thy help I'm come."

We may not have Ebenezer stones in our lives, but we do have Ebenezers none the less. It may be a picture, a letter, a scripture, or event that reminds us of God's faithfulness in our lives.

Our 50th Anniversary is certainly an Ebenezer for me as we celebrated God's faithfulness these past 50 years and look forward to His continued faithfulness in the years to come.

Take time to remember. Take time to reflect on all the ways God has blessed you. Take time to consider the wondrous works of the Lord. When we do this, it will spring forth praises of thanksgiving for all that He has done!
